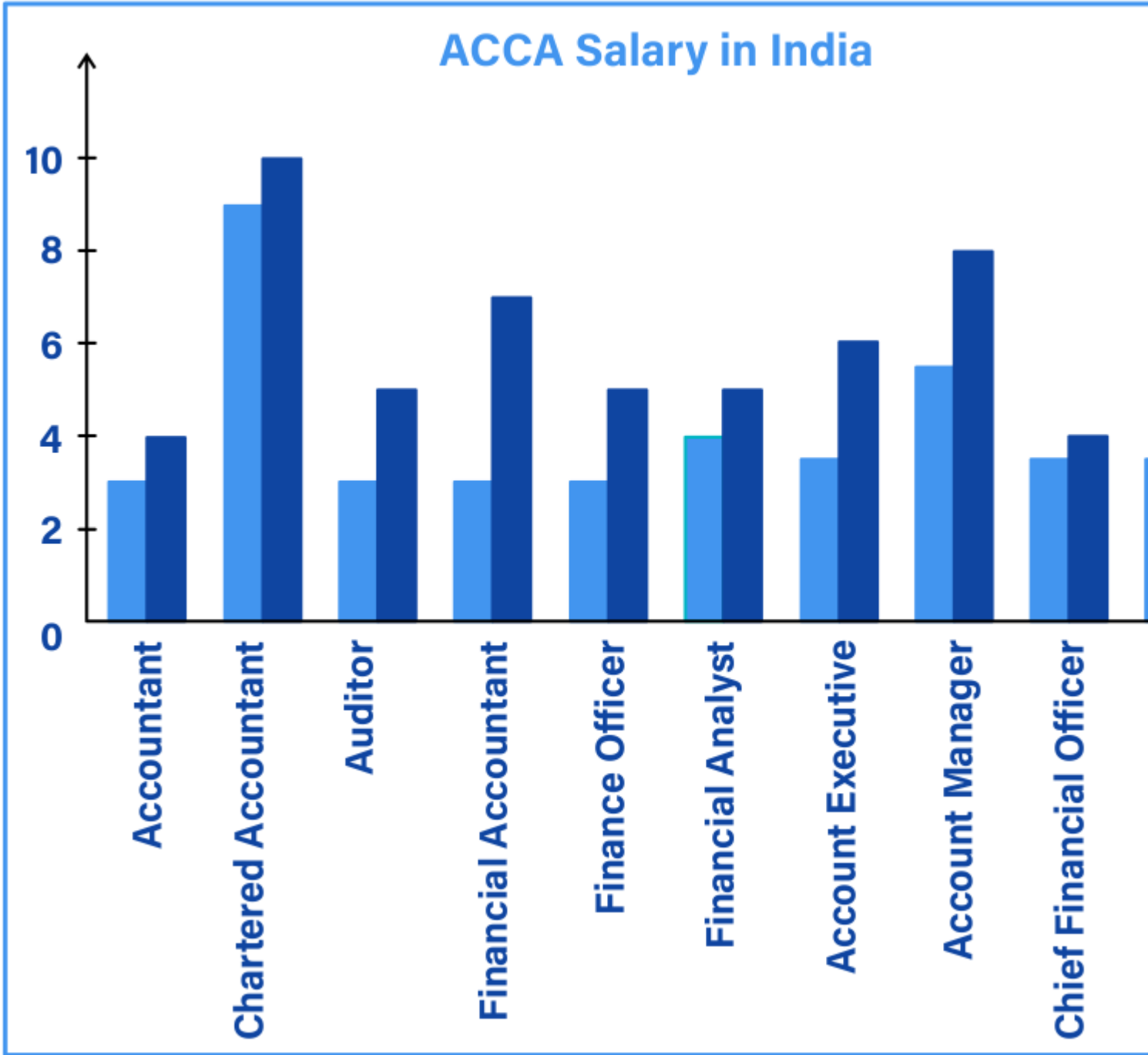
ACCA Salary in India

ACCA Salary Based on Experience

The roles of the members and their worth and recognition gives them high-salary member types which can be seen in escalations through salary scales from year after year. Salary after ACCA is heavily dependent on the experience level, the details of which have been stated below.

Entry-Level (0-2 Years of Experience) Entry-level role the wage brackets ₹6 to 10 lakhs per annum. When ACCA members gain experience they have great chances of boosting their salaries. The expected salary range for entry-level after ACCA in various countries have been mentioned below.

They are well-paid positions because of the degree they underpin in an industry. The salary is also dependent on the roles people take on. The details are stated below.

Financial Controller

Annual salary of a financial controller with ACCA credentials is between ₹15 to ₹30 lakhs. The range of salaries can be very broad depending on how large the company is, what industry it's in and where geographically this specific role lies. For senior financial controllers or individuals working at reputed MNCs, ACCAs can demand salaries more than ₹35 lakhs per annum indicating how proficient and specialized this Scottish associate professional course is in the strategic financial domain. Finance Director

Chief Financial Officer (CFO)

CFOs in top MNCs or lucrative industries, can draw salaries north of ₹75 lakhs per annum which further underlines the importance played by ACCA professionals in shaping and driving finances for big corporations. Salary of the chief financial officer has been stated below.

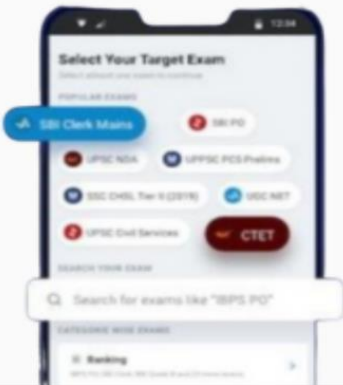
